




Message from the Regional Director





Car Museum Targeted


On June 24th someone threw a rock through the front door of the National Automobile Museum in Reno, NV. They followed that with a molotov cocktail, damaging two vehicles. The High Flyer, one of a couple dozen Volkswagen-powered trikes that Ed Roth built in the late Sixties sustained fire damage and the sprinkler system appeared to cause damage to a nearby vehicle, one of two factory-built gold-plated De Lorean DMC-12s

Thanks in part to security cameras, a suspect was quickly taken into custody.

The museum was reopened on July 2, after being closed to repair the damage. The damaged cars will be on display until they can be restored.

The Reno museum has a number of one-of-a-kind cars in it's collection of over 200 cars displayed in authentic looking street scenes.

Museum officials feel lucky that the fire did not spread and that the damage was minimal and most of it confined to the building itself. Had the fire spread or gotten out of control, it certainly would have been much, much worse.
