Some of you will remember Jack, as he was at one time, a member of the CCCA and the GIR.

Taylor was a TV news anchor in Chicago for more than 20 years, working alongside Len O'Connor, Harry Volkman and Jack Brickhouse. He went on to do news talk shows and business programs such as "The Wall Street Journal Report" and "The Stock Market Observer" In retirement, he did a weekly segment on the College of DuPage's radio station. Taylor estimated he'd done more than 50,000 interviews throughout his career, including with three presidents and many celebrities.
